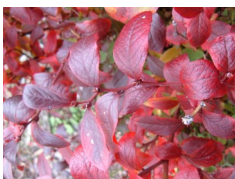


Cardinal Flower

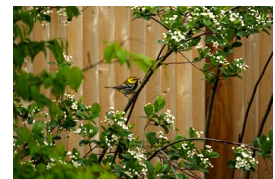

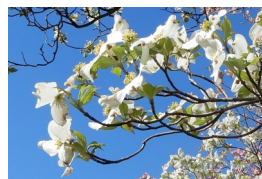


Black Chokeberry
(*Aronia melanocarpa*)

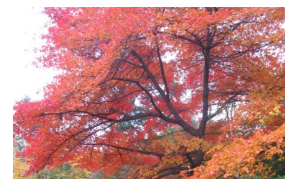
